For Elementary Education Transfer Students
Funded by the Margaret H. Steele Memorial Scholarship

The *Inspiring Women* scholarship recognizes academic achievement, leadership and extracurricular involvement while encouraging individuals to attain high levels of educational and professional achievement. The Margaret H. Steele Memorial Scholarship Endowment will award \$2,000 for the academic year to a transfer student who is a community college graduate and enrolled as an elementary education major. Students must have a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 (4.0=A) to be eligible to apply. The scholarship is renewable for one year as long as the recipient maintains full-time enrollment, a cumulative grade-point average of at least 3.0 (4.0 = A) and demonstrates University and/or community involvement. The scholarship will be funded each year from the endowment income and shall not be in excess of the accumulated income from the endowment at the time of the award.

To be considered for this award, applicants must submit the Inspiring Women Scholarship application and be admitted into SIUC by February 1 prior to the fall semester of attendance. Scholarship recipients will be required to attend a banquet in October.
